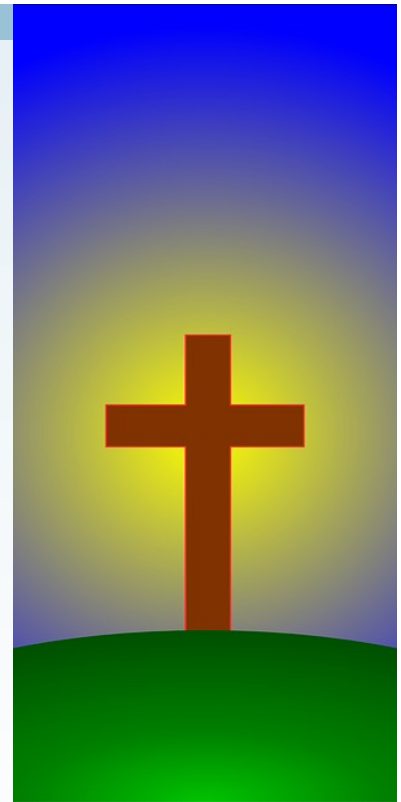
## DOM/AMS Notes from Bro. Jay Hatfield
